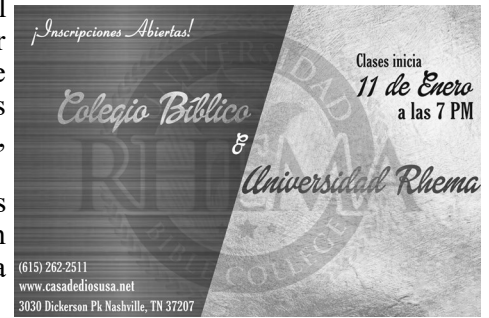

2. Desarrollar **SENSIBILIDAD** (vs. 3, 5).
