¡Aquellos que contemplamos, es en lo que nos convertimos; en lo que nos convertimos, es lo que impartimos! ¿A quién estamos contemplando? ¿En dónde está nuestro interés, atención, mirada?

Nuestro Padre Dios es amor (1 Jn. 4:8) y nosotros somos fruto de Su amor. No somos el fruto de una relación sexual, venimos del cielo; salimos del corazón de Dios; tenemos la capacidad de amar.

Entonces ¿qué es lo que pasa cuando sentimos tristeza o vacío? Cuando contemplamos a Dios nos llenamos de su amor y lo primero que se elimina en nuestra vida es el egoísmo, buscamos compartir y ayudar a otros; aceptamos a las personas con sus virtudes y errores, cuando Jesús miró a Saulo, no vio a un terrorista o un asesino, sino que vio a un apóstol (Pablo). El amor de Dios ya no nos deja ver, ni tratar, a las personas por su vida pasada (su historial, su expediente); el amor de Dios nos deja ver a las personas en su destino, su futura, vemos que la persona tiene un destino glorioso.

Cuando contemplamos a Dios nos llenamos de su amor y nos damos cuenta cuanta gente nos ama, nos admira; cuan valiosos somos, somos únicos en esta tierra. Somos hijos de Dios, disfrutemos Su amor, experimentémoslo.
