

MI CASA, UN LUGAR PARA DIOS “¡DIOS, Yo Reflejo Tú GRANDEZA!”

Cuando la fe se siembra, Dios se encarga de la cosecha. Isaías 55:8-9 nos dice: *“Porque mis pensamientos no son vuestros pensamientos, ni vuestros caminos mis caminos, dijo Jehová. Como son más altos los cielos que la tierra, así son mis caminos más altos que vuestros caminos, y mis pensamientos más que vuestros pensamientos.”*

Muchas personas quieren vivir una vida nueva sin perder sus viejas costumbres. No se puede avanzar sin cambiar. No se puede obtener resultados distintos sin pagar un precio de cambiar la actitud. El crecimiento no es agregar motivación a las personas, no es positivismo; **el crecimiento es fe.** No existe transformación, mientras que no exista pérdida. Tenemos que perder la vida vieja, las viejas actitudes, la vieja fe que no nos ha producido nada. No existe una nueva vida sin una nueva mente. No podemos desarrollar la mejor versión de nosotros mismos si queremos seguir protegiendo la vieja persona que llegó a Cristo. Las personas no fracasan por falta de capacidad, sino por lealtad a sus viejas costumbres: No leer la Biblia, no vivir lo que dice la Biblia, no creer lo que se predica y enseña; tienen lealtad a la pobreza, la escasez, las excusas, la ignorancia, etc. **¿Queremos vivir una vida nueva realmente? ¿Queremos tener nuevas bendiciones?** ¡Necesitamos cambiar nuestros pensamientos por los pensamientos de Dios!

La Palabra de Dios es la única que puede cambiar nuestra forma de pensar porque Dios la envía y es prosperada dentro de nosotros (Is. 55:10-12). La Palabra de Dios que recibimos será prosperada dentro de nuestro corazón, vida, mente, alma. Esta Palabra viene de la boca de Dios, no está vacía, está llena de salud, fuerza, nutrientes, vitaminas, riquezas; esta Palabra de Dios **nos está desafiando** a prosperar, nuestra vida no será igual por causa de la Palabra de Dios.

Dejemos la vieja forma de pensar, dejemos la lealtad a las malas costumbres, pongamos nuestra confianza en Dios ¡porque **cuando la fe se siembra, Dios se encarga de la cosecha!** Sembremos nuestra fe, estamos en temporada de **PRIMICIAS.**

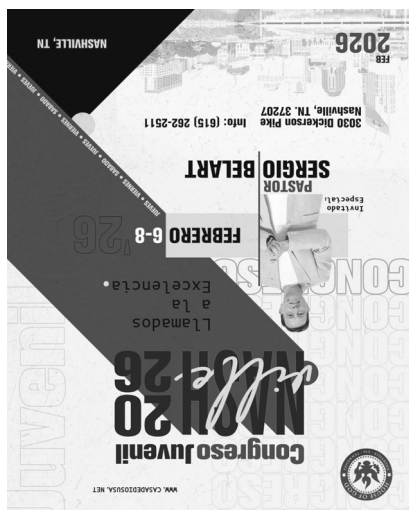
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MY HOUSE, A PLACE FOR GOD

“GOD, I Reflect Your GREATNESS!”

When faith is sown, God takes care of the harvest. Isaiah 55:8-9 tells us: *“For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways, declares the Lord. As the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways and my thoughts than your thoughts”.*

Many people want to live a new life without giving up their old habits. You cannot move forward without change. You cannot obtain different results without paying the price of changing your attitude. Growth is not about adding motivation to people; it's not about positive thinking; **growth is about faith.** There is no transformation without loss. We must lose old life, the old attitudes, the old faith that has produced nothing for us. There is no new life without a new mind. We cannot develop the best version of ourselves if we want to continue protecting the old person who came to Christ. People don't fail because of a lack of ability, but because of loyalty to their old habits: not reading the Bible, not living according to what the Bible says, not believing what is preached and taught; they are loyal to poverty, scarcity, excuses, ignorance, etc. **Do we truly want to live a new life? Do we want to receive new blessings?** We need to replace our thoughts with God's thoughts!

The Word of God is the only thing that can change our way of thinking because God sends it, and it prospers within us (Isaiah 55:10-12). The Word of God that we receive will prosper within our heart, life, mind, and soul. This Word comes from the mouth of God; it is not empty, but full of health, strength, nourishment, vitamins, and riches. This Word of God is **challenging us to prosper**; our lives will not be the same because of the Word of God.

Let's leave behind our old way of thinking, let's abandon our loyalty to bad habits, and let's place our trust in God, because **when faith is sown, God takes care of the harvest!** Let's sow our faith; we are in the season of FIRSTFRUITS.
