El profeta Hageo era un hombre que vivió en un tiempo de esclavitud, en una cultura muy difícil donde el pueblo era explotado y el gobierno era corrupto; pero Dios se complació en Hageo y lo escogió para hacer algo grande y poderoso. El libro que escribió el Profeta Hageo es Dios hablando a través de una persona; es recordar el acto de obediencia y reverencia hacia Dios.

Hageo busca restaurar la relación del pueblo de Israel con su creador, porque el pueblo, al pasar por un período de esclavitud, se habían acostumbrado a pensar como esclavos y, ahora que eran libres se le había olvidado que tenía un creador. Dios habla al pueblo por medio de Hageo y les pregunta: “¿Por qué viven ustedes en casas lujosas mientras Mi casa permanece en ruinas?” (Hageo 1:3 NTV). Dios les aclara que la situación económica por la que estaban pasando era consecuencia de su actitud indiferente hacia Él. Dios le dice: “¡Miren lo que les esta pasando! Han sembrado mucho pero cosechado poco; comen pero no quedan satisfechos; beben pero aún

tienen sed; se abrigan pero todavía tienen frío. Sus salarios desaparecen, ¡como si los echaran en bolsillos llenos de agujeros!”.

(Hageo 1:5-6 NTV). Dios los llama a la reflexión y reconocer que la situación precaria en la que se encontraban era porque se les había olvidado honrar a Dios. Dios usa a Hageo para decirle al Pueblo, y a nosotros: “Cuidado estas dejando a Dios en segundo plano y poniendo al trabajo y asuntos personales en primer lugar.” No dejemos que la indiferencia nos atrape y que la apatía nos arrope. Mucho cuidado con descuidar nuestra relación con nuestro creador. por eso, Varón, te animamos a que no te pierdas tu **ENCUENTRO CON DIOS**. Un **ENCUENTRO CON DIOS** es agarrar nuestra alma y llevarla a la presencia de un Dios maravilloso y poderoso. De un **ENCUENTRO** salimos sanos, prósperos, renovados y obtenemos experiencias sobrenaturales. ¡No debemos perdernos nuestro **ENCUENTRO CON DIOS** por nada del mundo!



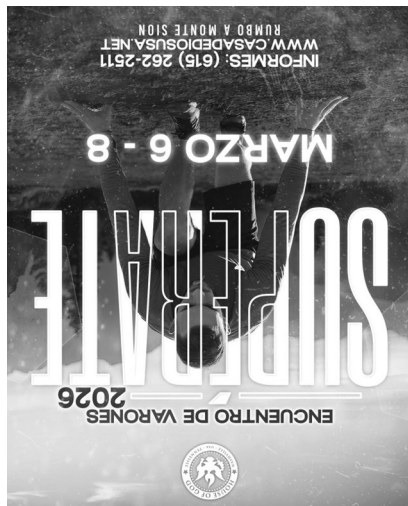

MY HOUSE, A PLACE FOR GOD

"GOD, I Reflect Your GREATNESS!"

The prophet Haggai was a man who lived in a time of slavery, in a very difficult culture where the people were exploited and the government was corrupt; but God was pleased with Haggai and chose him to do something great and powerful. The book that the Prophet Haggai wrote is God speaking through a person; it is a reminder of the act of obedience and reverence toward God.

Haggai sought to restore the relationship of the people of Israel with their Creator, because the people, having gone through a period of slavery, had become accustomed to thinking like slaves, and now that they were free, they had forgotten that they had a Creator. God speaks to the people through Haggai and asks them: **"Why do you live in luxurious houses while My house remains in ruins?"** (Haggai 1:3_NLT). God explains to them that their financial situation was a consequence of their indifferent attitude toward Him. God says, **"Look what is happening to you! You have sown much but reaped little; you eat but are not satisfied; you drink but are still thirsty; you put on clothes but are still cold. Your wages disappear, as if thrown into pockets full of holes!"** (Haggai 1:5-6_NLT). God calls them to reflect and recognize that their precarious situation was due to their neglect of God. God uses Haggai to tell the people, and us: "Be careful not to put God in second place and prioritize work and personal matters." Let us not allow indifference to trap us or apathy to envelop us. Be very careful not to neglect our relationship with our Creator. Therefore, man, we encourage you not to miss your **ENCOUNTER WITH GOD**. An **ENCOUNTER WITH GOD** is taking hold of our soul and bringing it into the presence of a wonderful and powerful God. From an **ENCOUNTER**, we emerge healed, prosperous, renewed, and we receive supernatural experiences. We must not miss our **ENCOUNTER WITH GOD** for anything in the world!
