

MI CASA, UNA CASA DE SABIDURÍA “¡DIOS, Yo Reflejo Tú GRANDEZA!”

“Si no tienes tiempo para leer la Biblia, mucho menos tiempo tienes para prosperar... ¡OPTIMIZATE!” Génesis es el Libro del **PRODUCTOR**, es el libro donde empieza la empresa y los negocios, es el libro para las personas que quieren salir de la pobreza y la escasez a los tesoros infinitos de Dios.

En Génesis 13 encontramos a un **PRODUCTOR** y a un **CONSUMIDOR**. Abraham (el productor) salió de Egipto (el mundo, el pecado, la limitación) con su sobrino Lot (el consumidor). Abraham era riquísimo y Lot, por causa de Abraham, también tenía muchos bienes, de tal forma que **“la tierra no era suficiente para que habitasen juntos, pues sus posesiones eran muchas”**; esto creo una contienda que no era de escasez, era de abundancia, a tal grado que tuvieron que separarse (vs. 6-13). Lot, como todo consumidor, escogió lo que ya estaba hecho, lo que representaba menos esfuerzo, sin importar el riesgo que ello representaba; Abraham, como buen productor, se fue a lo que representaba mas esfuerzo pero sabía que Dios estaba con él.

Después que Lot se separó de Abraham, fue que Dios le dijo a Abraham: **“Alza ahora tus ojos, y mira desde el lugar donde estás hacia el norte y el sur, y al oriente y al**

occidente. Porque toda la tierra que ves, la daré a ti y a tu descendencia para siempre.” Solo cuando nos apartemos de los consumidores, Dios nos mostrará el territorio que nos quiere dar. Cuidado con lo que puede estar estorbando nuestro crecimiento. **Hay personas que son equipo y hay personas que son equipaje.** La persona “equipo” trabaja con nosotros para que crezcamos juntos; la persona “equipaje” solo nos trae su carga, que no quiere cargar.

Dios nos dice como le dijo a Abraham: “Te doy toda la tierra que alcanzas a ver”. Afinemos nuestra mirada espiritual porque hasta donde alcancemos a ver es lo que Dios nos va a dar. Pero si estamos tan distraídos que no nos da tiempo para leer la Biblia, ¿Cómo podremos prosperar? Dios nos sigue diciendo: Levántate, ve por la tierra a lo largo de ella y a su ancho; porque a ti la daré.” ¿Qué nos toca hacer? Los mismo que hizo Abraham: Obedecer y edificar altar a Jehová. **Entramos en tiempo de CLAMOR A DIOS con el CAMBIO DE BANDERAS el 16 de septiembre.**

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MY HOUSE, A HOUSE OF WISDOM

“GOD, I Reflect Your GREATNESS!”

Week 37, there is left 15 weeks of the year 2026



“If you don’t have time to read the Bible, you have even less time to prosper... **OPTIMIZE YOURSELF!**” Genesis is the Book of the **PRODUCER**; it is the book where enterprise and business begin, and the book for people who want to move from poverty and scarcity into God’s infinite treasures.

In Genesis 13, we encounter a **PRODUCER** and a **CONSUMER**. Abraham (the producer) left Egypt (representing the world, sin, and limitation) with his nephew Lot (the consumer). Abraham was extremely wealthy, and Lot, thanks to Abraham, also possessed great riches; so much so that **“the land could not support them while dwelling together, for their possessions were so great.”** This sparked a conflict born not of scarcity, but of abundance, to the point where they had to part ways (vv. 6–13). Lot, like any consumer, chose what was already established, the path requiring less effort, regardless of the risks involved. Abraham, acting as a true producer, chose the path that required more effort, knowing that God was with him.

It was only after Lot had separated from Abraham that God spoke to him: **“Lift up your eyes now and look from the place where you are, northward, southward, eastward, and westward. For all the land which you see I give to you and your**

descendants forever.” Only when we separate ourselves from consumers will God reveal the territory He intends to give us. We must be wary of whatever might be hindering our growth. **There are people who are part of the team, and there are people who are merely baggage.** A “team” person works alongside us so we can grow together; a “baggage” person simply brings us the burden they refuse to carry themselves.

God speaks to us just as He did to Abraham: “I give you all the land you can see.” Let us sharpen our spiritual vision, for God will give us exactly as much as we can see. But if we are so distracted that we cannot find time to read the Bible, how can we possibly prosper? God continues to tell us: “Arise, walk through the land in its length and its width, for I will give it to you.” What must we do? The same thing Abraham did: obey and build an altar to the Lord. **We are entering a time of CRYING OUT TO GOD with the CHANGING OF THE FLAGS on September 16.**

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
